- **'Empowerment and the Sacred: An Interdisciplinary Conference' (Leeds University, UK)**

What: Conference at the Institute of Colonial and Postcolonial Studies, University of Leeds, 24th-26th June, 2011

Subject: At a moment when the 'resurgence of religion' is calling into question the secular orientation of global futures, we ask: isn't it time for cross-cultural, cross-disciplinary debate about the role that the sacred plays in our ideas and our histories of personal and collective agency, power and change? This conference will bring together scholars, arts-practitioners and professionals to investigate the ways in which sacred traditions - in diverse historical and cultural contexts - have shaped discourses and practices of empowerment, emancipation, change, resistance and survival.

Submission guidelines: Proposals are invited for 20 minute presentations, which address the relation between the sacred and empowerment, to be given at the conference.

Application deadline: March 30, 2011.

- **‘Collectivity beyond Identity’ (Humboldt University Berlin, Germany)**

What: International Conference ‘Collectivity beyond Identity’ at Humboldt Universität Berlin, June 28 - 30, 2012.

Subject: Modes of collectivity play an important role in numerous contexts of our social and everyday lives. Critical theory, however, has drawn our attention to the fact that collectives often result in exclusion and even violence. Following such critiques, various attempts have been made to provide more complex analyses of power relations. It appears that the problem of plurality cannot be responded to by invoking the notion of collective subjects. The critical tools of feminist theory, and in particular the input from Queer and Postcolonial Studies, point to a productive examination of belonging and (political) community.

Submission guidelines: The conference is bilingual (German/English) and transdisciplinary. Please send abstracts (one page in length) for papers suitable to be delivered in 20 minutes

(to be anonymously reviewed) to: zentrum@gender.hu-berlin.de. Please also include a short CV as a separate document with your submission.
