PHD TUTORIAL Professor Rosi Braidotti

The Netherlands Research School of Gender Studies (NOG) organizes a PhD tutorial with Professor Rosi Braidotti. This interdisciplinary tutorial provides an excellent opportunity for PhD students to work with one of the major scholars working on feminist theory, posthumanism, gender studies, and philosophy.

The format of the tutorial (in English) consists of four sessions with Braidotti and three preparatory working sessions run by the participating students themselves. Each session with Braidotti will start with a lecture by professor Braidotti.
